Rotating carousel and lighted interior

Pretend play food sold separately. Requires 3 AA batteries (not included in box for battery installation instructions)

Large, clear window for easy viewing

Listen for beeps when food is ready. Check countdown timer.



Watch carousel turn, interior light makes viewing easy.



Press a food button. Push START.



Place pretend food inside and close the door. Press OPEN. Door swings open.



Large enough for most plastic pretend play food.

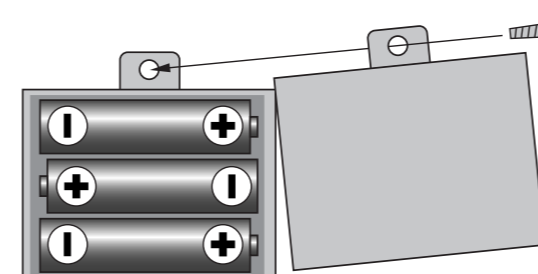

BATTERY INSTALLATION and INSTRUCTIONS

For the best operation, always use fresh alkaline batteries. Other battery types will have a shorter life.

- Carefully open the battery compartment door located on the bottom of the Microwave Oven by loosening the screw holding it in place.
- Install three fresh AA-cell (DC 1.5v) batteries in the battery compartment, carefully following the diagram below showing correct battery installation. A diagram can also be found inside the battery compartment.
 - Batteries must be inserted with the correct polarity.
 - Do not mix old and new batteries.
 - Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
 - Remove exhausted batteries from the unit.
 - The supply terminals must not be short-circuited.
 - Non-rechargeable batteries must not be recharged.
 - Do not use rechargeable batteries.
 - Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
 - To prevent corrosion and possible damage to the product, it is recommended to remove the batteries from the unit if it will not be used for more than two weeks.
- Close the battery compartment door and tighten the screw.
